Reports and Minutes

Ministry and Counsel:

- Members of MC continue to reach out to Tampa Friends who need pastoral support and recent visitors.
- Updates were given on the upcoming workshop planned with Jerry Knutson from Orlando Meeting.
- MC discussed the desire to have Friendly Dinners periodically, perhaps on a quarterly basis rather than monthly.
- MC is asking that the Committee of the Whole meet once per month for the next few months to help the vital ministries and activities of Tampa Meeting to be considered and promoted.
- Looking froward to July 2023, we realize there is at least one First Day when all the Friends who set up the meetinghouse for hybrid worship will be traveling; for at least that one day, worship will be online only. We will keep everyone updated on when that is.

• Property:

- Chris Hugues reported that the Tampa UCC did recently use the space for Maundy Thursday.
- The final cost to fix the A/C issue in the front building was about \$500; it has been repaired.
- o The grass cutting is very irregular right now because of the lack of rain.

• <u>Treasurer's report</u>:

- Donations doubled in March 23 compared to February 23.
- We paid some once-a-year bills like the Florida business license and one of the two meetinghouse termite plans.
- Friends were reminded that for the approximately \$28,000 in set asides, it is for major issues and would be depleted quickly if we needed (for instance) a new roof and a new air conditioner.
- The current financial report was accepted.
- The first reading of the 2023-2024 Budget was held.
 - Chris Hugues showed how we have spent more than we brought in for the past 3 years and reminded us that this is unsustainable.
 - A budget was presented that truly only put in the actual needs for operation for 2023-2024.
 - One Friend mentioned that the SEYM Earthcare Secretary role has become a staff member role of SEYM and no longer needs specific

funding; it was suggested we could remove that as an expense in the budget.

■ Second reading of the budget will be in May.
